

Saturday, November 11

Delight in Shabbat walking tours exploring Jerusalem. Optional Tracks:

- If Walls Could Speakvisit Yemin Moshe and Mahane Israel and hear the stories of the brave men and women that started a revolution by settling in the first houses located outside the Old City Walls.
- Discover the Old City of
 Jerusalem immerse yourself in
 the stories, traditions, and legends
 behind the stones in the ancient
 city with a historical, cultural,
 and archaeological tour. The tour
 includes a walk through the Jewish
 Quarter including the uncovered
 Roman Cardo the marketplace
 from the Roman era and the
 Western Wall, where the stones of
 the Second Temple are exposed.
- Walk along the route of the Ottoman Railway in Mesilla Park a lively urban park that connects different neighborhoods of Jerusalem.

Travel to Mount Herzl and the IDF Memorial Hall, Israel's National Cemetary, for a deeply meaningful and unforgettable ceremony.



- Experience visits to different sites of the Christian and Muslim Quarters, including the eminent Church of the Holy Sepulcher and the exquisite Arab Bassar, where you will take in Middle Eastern life with all its rich colors, flavors, and aromas.
- View the Old City from above and get a taste of all four quarters as you walk along the Old City ramparts.

- Embark on a morning journey to the IDF Southern Command's strategic border where we will meet with Brigadier General Avi Rosenfeld, the esteemed leader of the Gaza Brigade.
- The Sky's the Limit ... marvel in an afternoon visit to an Israeli Air Force base in the South (Hatzerim, Ramon or Nevatim). Meet courageous IDF fighter pilots.
- Savor an exquisite dinner at the hotel followed by a festive celebration.

Tuesday, November 14

- Learn from a panel discussion with Tal Ohana, Mayor of Yerucham and a senior officer of the IDF responsible for the relocation and development of the IDF moving to the Negev, moderated by FIDF CEO, Steve Weil.
- Visit the Presidential Library in Sde Boker, a joint venture of Ben-Gurion University and Ben-Gurion Heritage Institute, where hundreds of thousands of documents, diaries and protocols of Israel's first prime minister have been collected, and shed new light on the state's first days.
- IDF in Action: Visit one of the IDF's southern training bases: Shizafon (Armored Corps), Shivta (Artillery Corps), or Bislach (Infantry Brigade).
- Meet the next generation of IDF commanders at Bahad 1, IDF Officers Training Center, and enjoy lunch together.
